### **Toiletries Bags** for Impact for Women

Impact is a volunteer run charity making a difference to women and children fleeing extreme violence at home. The drawstring toiletry bags we make are filled by volunteers with gifts and distributed for Mothers' Day and Christmas. They deliver more than 2,000 on each occasion.

Since our 2023 contribution of 261 bags was delivered in August, we have already made another 85 towards this year's contribution. Thanks to everyone who has already made some, and those who will do some during 2024.
