# Caring Quilts Update for June from Carolyn Sweeting

#### **Quilts for residents in Aged Care Homes**

Since my last report we have donated 11 quilts and knitted lap rugs to Vasey RSL Care in Frankston South. The same afternoon I received an email from Ruwan, the Lifestyle Coordinator to say "Thank you so much for this great donation. I've already distributed them to our residents, and they are so happy to receive them and thanked you all for this donation."

#### **Toiletry Bags for Impact for Women**

So many members are contributing to this project, and more completed bags come in every time we meet. I have been cutting out bags to the correct size for anyone who wants to take them ready-to-sew, and these, and the cords and instruction sheets are available whenever we meet at Tyabb. Much of the fabric for the bags has come from donations to the club, and some from my stash. I know others are also using their own stashes to make bags as well, and I think the women who receive them full of goodies will probably appreciate the beautiful bags as much as the contents. We have currently accumulated 262 bags, but by the time we meet at our June meeting I'm pretty sure that number will have grown.

We're already collecting more **Premmie Quilts** for the Frankston Hospital Special Care Unit, quilts for **Aged Care** residents, and quilts and knitted toys towards our next donation to **Wheelchairs for Kids**.

#### The sizes required for each category are

Premmie Quilts - 20" x 30" (approx. 50x76 cm) with a darkish backing.

Wheelchairs for Kids - about 36"-39" square (about a yard or a metre square).

Aged Care quilts – about 38"-45" square or rectangular, suitable for women or men.

It is quite important to stick to the recommended sizes for Premmie and Wheelchair quilts, because they need to be used with equipment.

The Aged Care quilt sizes are a bit more flexible, but they will be used as lap quilts in chairs, not on beds.

Thank you for your continued support of our Caring Quilts program with you sewing, and donations of fabric and cords and ribbons for Toiletry Bags.

## **Members Recipes**

#### **Rolled Oat Bars**

I cup Whole meal SR Flour 2 cups Oats

½ Cup Sugar 160 Grams butter

1 tablespoon Golden syrup

#### Method

Combine oats, flour and sugar in a bowl

Melt butter and golden syrup. Mix into dry ingredients

Press into paper lined slice tray (I precut before baking)

Bake for 14 to 20 minutes until brown

Cut into bars while till hot leave in the tray to cool

#### **lcing**

½ cup icing sugar add vanilla or lemon juice to make a thin mixture to drizzle over cooked bars.

### **Energy Muffins**

2/3 cup caster sugar

1 1/3 cup SR Flour Sift together in a large bowl

½ teaspoon cinnamon

2/3 cup Sultanas

1 1/3 cup grated carrot Add to flour mix

1 grated apple Mix to combine

2/3 cup coconut

2 eggs

1 teaspoon vanilla essence

2/3 cup canola oil Mix together in a measuring jug

Add dry mix to bowl and stir until just combined

Spoon into muffin pans and bake for 25 mins until golden

Can sprinkle a little raw sugar over muffins before cooking.
