Please think about how you can help at the club so we can continue to see it grow and remain vibrant.


Even if you only have time to volunteer to do Kitchen Duty or the Welcome Desk, this helps to keep our club functioning.

Caring Quilts Update for September from Carolyn Sweeting

Toiletry Bags for Impact for Women

Recently we donated 384 Toiletry Bags for our 2024 donation. That is over 100 more than in 2023.

Thank you so much for all your efforts towards making Toiletry Bags for the women who have escaped severe domestic violence and are supported by gifts from Impact for Women. Members of Westernport Quilters supported the initiative by donating fabric and ribbon, cutting, sewing, and threading the bags.

Our 2024 donation was recently collected just in time for another bag-filling session by volunteers and will be among those distributed before Christmas 2024 and Mothers' Day 2025. Lisa (from Impact) explained to me that getting a really good stock of bags at this time of the year is terrific, because there is such a short turnaround time between Christmas and April, when the Mothers' Day bags are distributed.

We already have 16 bags towards our 2025 donation. Brilliant!

Premmie Quilts

14 Premmie Quilts will be delivered to the Frankston Hospital Special Care Unit in September. Many of this latest collection were shown at the Saturday Sit and Sew, including one which Brenda Dean brought down from Queensland. Thanks to everyone who has made these delightful little quilts or is planning to.

Wheelchair Kids and Aged Care Quilts are building up in our storeroom ready for delivery at a later date.

The sizes required for the following categories of our Caring Quilts Programme are

Premmie Quilts – 20" x 30" (approx. 50x76 cm) with a darkish backing.

Wheelchairs for Kids - about 36"-39" square (about a yard or a metre square).

Aged Care quilts – about 38"-45" square or rectangular, suitable for women or

men.

We have a roll of **batting** in our storeroom for anyone who needs a piece for any of the Caring Quilts they are making. See Carolyn at any Meeting or Sit and Sew if you'd like a piece, preferably knowing the size you need!
