Caring Quilts Update for October from Carolyn Sweeting

Toiletry Bags for Impact for Women

After a magnificent effort we made our annual donation of drawstring bags in August, and already we have 29 bags towards our 2025 donation.

Members are using their own stash of fabrics, as well as taking advantage of the precut fabrics available at our regular gatherings. We have also received donations of ribbons and cords, and these, as well as instruction sheets, are available at our gatherings as well.

Remember, the finished size needs to be 12×16 inches.

We are also accumulating quilts in the following categories

Premmie Quilts – 20" x 30" (approx. 50x76 cm) with a darkish backing.

Wheelchairs for Kids – about 36"-39" square (about a yard or a metre square).

Aged Care quilts – about 38"- 45" square or rectangular, suitable for women or men.

These are delivered to where they need to go in collections of about 10 or more.

Through Satu, we have discovered that the **Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre will take quilts of any size,** so if anyone wants to donate a quilt there you may like to take advantage of Satu's kind offer to deliver them when she visits the Centre from time to time.

We have a roll of **batting** in our storeroom for anyone who needs a piece for any of the Caring Quilts they are making. See Carolyn at any Meeting or Sit and Sew if you'd like a piece, preferably knowing the size you need!
